Awards & Bios: People's Choice Award certificates will be awarded at the end of the show to the artwork selected by ballot from the general public viewing for both 2D and 3D artwork. An Artist Biography book will be provided at the entrance to the exhibit with a biographical sketch about each artist. A one page biography should be supplied by each artist with their application.

Dimensions: Framed size of wall mounted work not to exceed 36" x 36". Sculptures and other 3-dimensional artwork may not exceed 60" vertically and 30" horizontally, or weigh more than 50 pounds and must be free standing.

Delivery/ Pickup: Artists will be responsible for hand-delivery of work to and pick-up from the Art Center. Artwork delivery date is **May 4, 2019**. Date for artwork pick up is **June 9, 2019**. The artist is responsible for any insurance on his/her work during transit and exhibition. No artwork is to be shipped directly to The Art Center.

Eligibility: All artists must be an active member of the Blue Ridge Mountains Arts Association (BRMAA) and the Southern Appalachian Artists Guild (SAAG). Original artworks in two dimensional or three dimensional medium or style, including but not limited to painting, drawing, fiber art, pottery, jewelry, stained and blown glass, clay, metal, stone, woodwork, sculpture, folk art, photography, and mixed media, may be submitted. Prints and gicleés will not be accepted. All artworks must be marked "for sale" – artwork marked "not for sale" or "NFS" will not be accepted.

Entry: Agreement submission deadline is April 13, 2019. Artworks to be hung must be wired and ready for hanging with all necessary hardware in place. No modifications to prepare a piece for exhibition will be done by the Art Center. Neither artwork nor mounting panels may be screwed or bolted to any wall in the Art Center galleries. All artwork must be "for sale" – artwork marked "not for sale" or "NFS" will not be accepted. The Art Center will make the final determination of display arrangement and also reserves the right to not display all pieces submitted.

Sales: Participating artists will receive a 70% commission of the retail price and BRMAA will retain a 30% commission on all exhibition sales. The price submitted on Entry Form (attached) will be the price represented throughout the duration of the show. Georgia sales tax (7%) will be added at the point of sale. Changes to set retail price will not be accepted.

Liability: Neither BRMAA nor any of their representatives will be held responsible for lost or damaged artworks. The artist is responsible for any insurance on his/her work during transit and exhibition. While utmost care is given to all entries, BRMAA and the Art Center do not assume any liability for damage or loss, before, during or after exhibition.

Agreement: Submission of works to this exhibition constitutes agreement on the part of the artist to all terms and conditions of this entire prospectus, which includes, but is not limited to, the right of BRMAA to use entries for publicity.
